## INVITATION

You are cordially invited to participate in our celebration of five-year anniversary of NMR centre at National Institute of Chemistry marking the acquisition of 600 MHz NMR spectrometer.

The main purpose of this two-day mini-symposium is to illustrate to chemists from industry as well as from academia the actual possibilities, limitations and future developments in the use of NMR spectroscopy.

Recently NMR center was selected to be the only 'Center of Excellence' in Slovenia and this meeting will promote networking and cooperation with institutions all over EU and Europe.

## SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

The conference will be a two-day event with invited plenary lecturers and several oral presentations. Younger colleagues will be invited to present their research with posters.

In addition we plan to review our scientific achievements in front of members of international community and to celebrate the fifth anniversary of NMR centre in Ljubljana.

Main deliverables of the symposium:

- Increased networking between NMR centres inside EU countries and pre-accession countries,
- Contribution to capacity building through attracting young researchers,
- Increased scope of the centre and support for economic and social needs of the region,
- Introduction of students and senior scientists to the most modern methods of application of NMR spectroscopy in chemistry, biology and related areas.
